We are pleased to inform you that your child may have the opportunity to participate in the IEA (International Association for the Evaluation of Educational Achievement) TIMSS (Trends in International Mathematics and Science Study) Program, which is scheduled starting April 2023 in select schools.

TIMSS is an important international assessment that evaluates student performance in Mathematics and Science in Grades 4 and 8 (Years 5 and 9) every four years.

Your child's participation will give them a unique opportunity to experience a global assessment administered in more than 65 countries and will help them foster a better understanding of their own abilities because they will be able to apply their knowledge to solve real-world mathematics problems and conduct virtual science experiments and investigations.

TIMSS also enables educators to harness collective insights that will support the improvement of educational programs, teaching practices and other important factors that impact student learning. Your child's valuable participation will contribute to national and international data to support and improve the quality of education across schools in Abu Dhabi.

This assessment is private and will not affect your child's outcomes at school. It will help them grow and we would appreciate it if you would extend your guidance and encourage them to be well-rested and do their best for their own benefit and the collective benefit of our education community.
